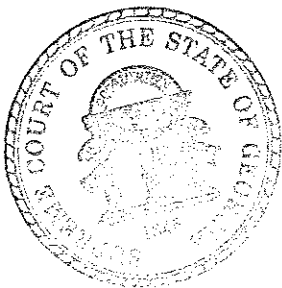
The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.  
The following order was passed:

It is ordered that Part B, Section 7 of the Rules Governing the Admission to the Practice of Law be amended to read as follows:

Section 7: Re-Examination


There shall be no limit on the number of times an applicant may take the examination. However, once an applicant fails the bar examination three (3) times, the applicant will not be eligible to sit for the next available examination.

If this applicant fails any subsequent examination, the applicant must sit out the next available examination.
