The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.


The following order was passed:

It is hereby ordered that Part B, Section 2. Applications for Examinations, of the Rules Governing Admission to the Practice of Law in Georgia, be amended by changing the language of subsection (b) by striking the numerals "\$75.00" and inserting in lieu thereof the numerals "\$90.00" so that such subsection shall read as follows:

Section 2. Applications for Examinations

(b) Applications to take the bar examination shall be filed with the Office of Bar Admissions on a form prescribed by the Board of Bar Examiners and shall be accompanied by a fee of \$90.00 payable to the Board of Bar Examiners and an additional fee payable to the National Conference of Bar Examiners. **Prior to filing such application, each applicant must obtain from the Board to Determine Fitness of Bar Applicants a certificate of fitness to practice law.** An applicant will not be allowed to file an application or take the examination who has not first received such a certificate.

Further, evidence that the applicant meets the educational requirements set forth in these Rules must be submitted contemporaneously with his or her application.
