

Civility Policy of the Board to Determine Fitness of Bar Applicants

Applicants for admission to the State Bar of Georgia must:

- Strive to uphold the honor and dignity of the legal profession and to conduct themselves in accordance with the Georgia Rules of Professional Conduct and <u>Aspirational Statement on Professionalism</u>.
- Speak and write civilly and respectfully in all communications with the Office of Bar Admissions and its personnel.
- Conduct themselves with dignity and refrain from engaging in acts of rudeness, disrespect, or disorder with respect to the Office of Bar Admissions, its personnel, and other bar applicants.

Violations of this Civility Policy may be reported by the Office of Bar Admissions to the Board to Determine Fitness of Bar Applicants for further review and possible denial or suspension of the applicant's certification of fitness.
