Process to Convert the Two-Day Fitness Application to the One-Day Fitness Application for the Attorneys' Exam

Conversion **only** applies to those applicants who have submitted a two-day fitness application to take the regular two-day bar exam, but then later qualify to take the one-day Attorneys' Exam. Once you have determined that you meet the eligibility requirements for the Attorneys' Exam (as provided in Section 2 of Part D of our Rules), send an email to the address found here with the following documents:

- a signed and notarized copy of the One-Day Georgia Attorneys' Examination Affidavit;
- a current Letter of Good Standing from every jurisdiction in which you are admitted to practice law; and
- a current Disciplinary History Record from every jurisdiction in which you are admitted to practice law.

You will be contacted by a staff member of the Office of Bar Admissions about payment. The fee for converting is the difference between the amount you paid (excluding late fees) for the Fitness Application for the Two-Day Exam (this amount varies depending on how long an applicant has been out of law school) and the \$900 filing fee for the Fitness Application for the Attorneys' Exam. Payment must be received by the deadlines postedbelow.

The deadline to convert for the February Bar Exam is the preceding January 5th at 4:00 p.m.

The deadline to convert for the July Bar Exam is the preceding June 1st at 4:00 p.m.
